POLICY

Frøy ASA, hereby referred to as "Frøy", aim to provide complete solutions for the ocean space.

As a service provider for many of the world's largest aquaculture farmers in the world, Frøy handle fish that is to become dinners for many million families in the world. Therefore, Frøy is highly committed towards sustaining a high food safety standard throughout all our activities. Our strict internal hygiene standards live up to the requirements of national legal standards and those set by our customers.

Frøy is a Global G.A.P. verified supplier and is annually externally audited to make sure we are living up to the standards of food safety for the aquaculture sector.

Additionally, Frøy is regularly audited by a selection of customers according to topics within the Aquaculture Stewardship Council (ASC) standard.

Our vessels are required to keep a high cleanliness standard between missions and are never to wash and disinfect near farms with fish inside.

Frøy commit to using only approved oils in systems that are in contact with fish in our wells, to prevent possible pollution of the fish should accidents or spills happen.

Our KPIs:

Frøy shall have zero incidents of poor fish welfare.

Frøy shall have zero biosafety incidents with serious consequence.

Frøy shall have zero spills of harmful oils, fuels, chemicals or other that can be harmful to fish and environment.

Frøy is to transition towards using solely food-approved hydraulic oils on Frøy vessels, to protect fish and environment should accidents happen
