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# Freshwater Management Policy

## POLICY

The use of freshwater is a central part of Frøy's operations.

Freshwater is used for delousing-operations and of course by our employees to keep up with basic hygiene and hydration. The access to fresh water is scarce in some areas of the world, and a resource under heavy pressure. Therefore, it is important to protect and preserve these sources of water.

Frøy has its base of largely within Norway and are privileged with easy access to large amounts of safe, clean, fresh water.

In global surveying of water risk, Norway has an overall low risk

[1]. International activities in Frøy which take place in Great Britain and Iceland, are also in areas with low to medium overall water risk. Frøy is therefore operating in areas with low water risk.

We are continuously working towards increasing the efficiency of our usage of fresh water on board all our boats, while maintaining high hygiene standards.

Frøy commits to reducing its usage of freshwater connected to our well boat activities through producing fresh water on board. Frøy is committed to continue its use of technology and methods that reduce our usage of freshwater where it is possible and appropriate.
